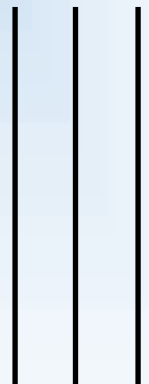

## What is "Fuse"

In 2014, Hopewell Industries (HWI) in Coshocton, and LICCO in Licking County and entered into the first alliance of privatized providers in the state of Ohio. In 2016, Muskingum Starlight Industries (MSI) joined the alliance with HWI and LICCO merging the three organizations into one:

### The Fuse Network.



We are a 501 (3) C non-profit organization governed by our Board of Directors (Board Leaders) representing each respective county.

## Supports and Services

### Community Employment Services

includes career discovery and exploration as well as job seeking. Once a job has been secured, support can be provided to assist with the on-boarding experience at the new job as well as coaching and long-term retention support.

### Community Integrated Adult Day Services

builds independence skills, community membership, relationship building as well as self-advocacy skills. Individuals can receive a combination of community integration services as well as supports provided within our program sites.

### Vocational Habilitation Supports

the individual in building the skills necessary for future community employment. Individuals will learn soft skills, including but not limited to, staying focused on task, conversational skills and general workplace expectations. VocHab can occur within our program sites, community partner locations and group employment sites.

### Home & Community Based Supports

individuals in and out of their homes with a goal of creating connections that support a valued social role within the community. Our services can also assist people to be successful in their home and with typical household living responsibilities.
